

The Blessings Box is Coming!

Mission/Evangelism has been working with session and other church members to have a Blessings Box built for First Presbyterian Church! Thanks to Lisa Eickholt, we were able to find a volunteer to build our box!

If you are unfamiliar with a Blessings Box, it is a wooden box that will be mounted and placed somewhere on the premises, that will offer food and hygiene items for those in need. The saying that adorns many Blessings Boxes is, GIVE WHAT YOU CAN, TAKE WHAT YOU NEED, AND MAY ALL BE BLESSED! It is not meant to replace resources such as the Food Pantry or Wheels of Hope, but rather to offer a stop gap to those in immediate need.

How can you help? Once our box is mounted, it will need to be stocked! Nonperishable food items, such as peanut butter, noodles, canned soups, etc. are welcome. Hygiene items, such as we've collected for other groups, are also welcome, toothpaste, diapers, soap, etc. We will have a small committee that checks the box to make sure it's well stocked and taken care of. If you are interested in helping with that committee, especially if you live in town, please let Jenna know! The giving for the Blessing Box will be separate from the Food Pantry donations, as we don't want to take away from that ministry. Donations for the Blessings Box will be made directly to the box.

You can find more information on Blessings Boxes by googling it, and I have attached a picture as an example. There are several other Blessings Boxes in other areas of Junction City, but we are excited to open one in this part of town! When it is completed, we will be posting on our church Facebook page! Thank you for praying for this project and for those in need who will access it! We look forward to any questions you might have!
